We will invite Unitarians / Universalists from our global community to offer workshops and trainings that will deepen our connections to one another as well as strengthen our diverse identity as religious liberals. Participants will gain experience in multicultural religious conversation and be invited to explore how then to share those conversations with their faith communities.



We invite you to join us and our hosts, the Unitarian Union of North East India (UUNEI), for our 2018 Conference being held for the first time in the Khasi Hills of India where they have been living Unitarian/Universalist values and faith for generations. Join us for learning and inspiration, worship and conversation, and of course, good food, all in a beautiful corner of India.

WHERE WE ARE STAYING

We will stay and meet at the Earle Holiday Home in downtown Shillong. The hotel puts us within walking distance of the heart of the city, where we will be able to enjoy the dynamic energy of the Khasi Hills, and it also has one of the best restaurants in the city. We will use the meeting spaces at Earle Holiday for all our programming as well. Accommodation selection will be handled separately from registration. Once you register, you will be sent an accommodation form in which you will be able to select from the many levels of room type available so you will have many options to choose from to meet your needs.

HOW TO GET THERE

We recommend that you fly into Guwahati airport. You will likely fly through Delhi or Mumbai and then onto Guwahati. We do not suggest you attempt to fly into Shillong, because the airport is not consistently open and you risk having your flight cancelled. You will be greeted at the Guwahati airport by one of our UUNEI hosts. They will direct you to one of the coaches we have arranged to bring you directly to Shillong.

THINGS TO KNOW

The following are a few things to keep in mind as you make your plans to come to India.

IMPORTANT: *Please purchase travel insurance to cover cancellations as once reservations are made, payments cannot be refunded.*

Visas

Most participants from outside India will need to apply for a visa to enter India. You will need to apply for a TOURIST VISA. India now has an online process for visa applications, which we recommend. However, you will have to wait to apply for the visa until 30 days prior to your date of travel to India. The process will require an electronic copy of your passport photo page and an electronic copy of a passport-sized recent photo of you. You submit these online and usually hear a response within 3-5

business days. Please be sure to review the Indian Visa website at <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/index.html> for further details.

Spending Money

If you wish to obtain Rupees for some spending money, there are ATMs in the city center at which you will be able to use your debit card to receive Rupees. If you bring cash with you to exchange, your best option is to change it at the airport either in Delhi or Mumbai. There are banks in Shillong that may be able to change currencies, but your best option is to get cash via an ATM. This will give you the best exchange rate and is also the safest.

Language

The language for worship, presentations, workshops, and main sessions will be in English.

Worship

Each day begins with a communal act of worship led by participants from several countries. These services are an opportunity to share in the spiritual practice of other cultures.



Chalice Circles

These are an opportunity to meet daily with a small group of participants from other countries, getting to know each other, focusing on elements of faith and spirituality. Lifelong friendships and connections are often formed in Chalice Circles.



Young Adults Program

Young adults (ages 21-35) are again especially encouraged to attend the ICUU Council Meeting and Conference. In addition to participating in the general programming, young adults are provided an enriching program throughout the week, including leadership building, workshops, and social time.

Special funding will be available for young adults for all or part of the cost. To be eligible for these funds, young adults will need to fill out a separate request form in addition to the Council Meeting and Conference online registration.
